


Additional Recommendations for Layout Designers Preparing Files for Magazines with Perfect Binding

Cover and First/Last Inside Page Spread:

Allow **6 mm of space near the spine** for glueing.


Explanation: The inner 6 mm on both the cover and the first/last inside page (the edges closest to the spine) will be glued and not visible. This area may obscure parts of images, text, or other content.



Inside Page Spreads Near the Spine:

Be aware that a **portion of the inner edge** of each inside page spread will be hidden due to the binding.

Explanation: Depending on the paper thickness and total number of pages, **0 to 3 mm** of the inner edge (next to the spine) may not be visible. Avoid placing important elements like text or key parts of images in this area.



General recommendations:

- ✓ You can compensate for hidden areas by including extra space in the file.
- ✓ Try to avoid placing sensitive elements such as faces, logos, QR codes, phone numbers, prices, etc., in the hidden areas.
